


(Summary of Purpose of Ordinance No. 4: The purpose of this ordinance is to establish minimum standards for the design, development and improvement of all new subdivisions and resubdivisions so that existing developments will be protected and so that adequate provisions are made for public services, and to promote the health, safety, and general welfare in Page County, Iowa.)

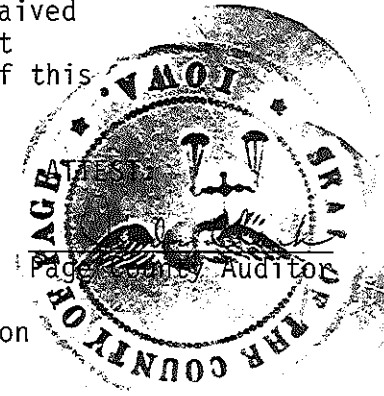
Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Page County, Iowa:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 4 of the Code of Ordinances of Page County, Iowa is repealed in its entirety and Section 409.1, Code of Iowa, 1987, will be followed in regard to the minimum standards for the design, development and improvement of all new subdivisions and resubdivisions.

SECTION 2: WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

By a unanimous vote of the Board of Supervisors on October 27, 1988, the first and second readings of Ordinance No. 6 are waived and the third and final reading will be November 10, 1988, at 11:00 a.m., at which time a vote will be taken for passage of this Ordinance No. 6.
