Title. An Ordinance Readopting The Existing County Code of Page County, Iowa.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors or Page County, Iowa. 91 OCT -9 AM 8:25

SECTION 1. Purpose. In accordance with Code of Iowa, Section 331.302, subsection 9, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect. CLARINDA, IOWA


SECTION 2. The following ordinances have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the law provides. They are stated herein by number and subject matter and by the authority of the Page County Board of Supervisors, comprise the Page County Code of Ordinances:

1. An Ordinance Establishing Policy of Clearance of Snow or Ice and Maintenance of County Secondary Roads during Winter Months.
2. An Ordinance Establishing Area Service "B" Road Classifications.
3. An Airport Tall Structure Zoning Ordinance.
4. An Ordinance Establishing Minimum Standards for design, development and improvement of all new subdivisions and resubdivisions so that existing developments will be protected and so that adequate provisions are made for public services, and to promote the health, safety and general welfare in Page County, Iowa--REPEALED.
5. Readoption of Existing Ordinances--October 7, 1986.
6. An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances of Page County, Iowa, 1986, by Repealing Ordinance No. 4.
7. An Ordinance Authorizing Partial Industrial Property Tax Exemption.
8. An Ordinance to adopt verbatim Chapters 567-39, 567-49 and 567-69 of the Iowa Administrative Code--regarding plugging abandoned wells, non-public water well rules, and on-site wastewater treatment and disposal system requirements.

SECTION 3. Code of Ordinances. Copies of the Code as adopted herein shall be on file and available for public inspection in the office of the County Auditor, Courthouse, Clarinda.

SECTION 4. When Effective. This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

By a unanimous vote of the Board of Supervisors on October 8, 1991, the first and second readings of Ordinance No. 9 are waived and the third and final reading was unanimously approved on October 8, 1991.
